<p>Program Services:</p>	<p><i>Passport to Life</i> seeks to address the housing and social support needs of former foster young women through culturally relevant social and human services. We will provide cost-<b>FREE</b>-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. safe, nurturing environment with private sleeping quarters for up to 3-years (included: hot meals, bedding and toiletries)</li><li>2. case management services</li><li>3. education assistance</li><li>4. employment assistance</li><li>5. life skills training</li><li>6. follow-up services</li><li>7. create proprietary database to accurately identify the needs of the community</li></ol>
<p>Entry Requirements:</p>	<p>Young women who enter the program –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• must be able to attend school or vocational training fulltime and work part-time</li><li>• willing to accept supportive services provided by various community agencies</li><li>• open to a life skills training curriculum which is tailored to address individual need, but not limited to our core services</li></ul>
